# ACTIVITIES CHRONOLOGICALLY

## Activity 1 Ejo Heza Anti-Drug Youth Campaign

**Date:** 30 September 2025

**Location:** Rutare Sector, Gicumbi District

**Partner:** Tumenye Amategeko Yacu Initiative

### Summary:

Youth session focused on drug-abuse prevention and legal education based on Laws N°71/2024 and N°59/2008.(GBV)

### Key Outcomes:

- Strong youth awareness on drug dangers
- Understanding legal implications
- Strengthened collaboration

This campaign marked a turning point for many young people who had never received clear guidance on drugs and the law. By opening their eyes to the dangers and showing them a path of responsibility, Imboni Generation planted the seeds of a drug-free generation.

**Location:** GS Kirwa

### Summary:

Empowered students to avoid drugs, embrace education, and practice leadership.

- Stronger knowledge of protective laws.

## Activity 3 GS Kinjojo Youth Empowerment

**Date:** 04 October 2025

**Location:** Rutare Sector, Gicumbi districts

### Summary:

Students were equipped with knowledge about drug abuse, positive choices, and values for leadership.

- Encouraged responsible behavior
- Reinforced youth empowerment movement

# SUPPORTING SCHOOL DROPOUTS & STREET BOYS

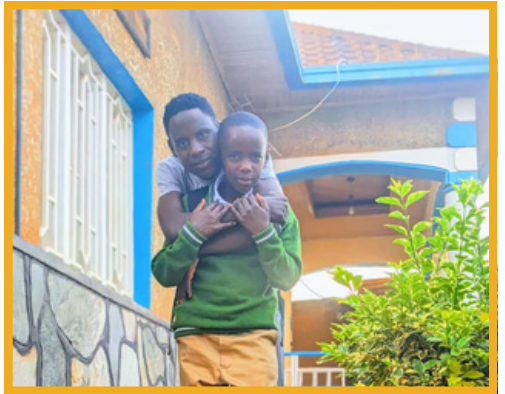
**Date:** Throughout 2025

# SUPPORTING STUDENTS AT GS KINJOJO – NEW YEAR, NEW HOPE

**Date:** 05 January 2026

## **Summary:**

A school outreach visit to GS Kinjojo in Rutare Sector, Gicumbi District, aimed at inspiring students at the start of the new year. The activity focused on sharing hope, encouragement, and practical support through a communal lunch and provision of essential school materials.

## **Key Outcomes:**

- Shared lunch with 59 students, fostering a sense of care and belonging
- Provided school materials to support learning continuity
- Inspired students with the message of “New Year, New Hope”, boosting motivation and confidence
